

# MINI STICK ARENA



## WHAT IS IT?

A safe, small-scale hockey arena for indoor play, designed for kids and families.

## WHAT DOES IT LOOK LIKE?

- 13 x 25 ft (leaves plenty of room for fire escape and current traffic)
- 6 ft of knotless netting surround
- 72 lineal feet of puck board 42 inch high
- Gate for entry and exit
- Can be removable or fixed in place



## KEY BENEFITS

- Encourages active play
- Reduces risks by giving children a designated place to play
- Patrons can participate in the arena and supervise their children in the mini-stick area
- Creates a social hub that will increase overall membership and duration of visits. This will drive more traffic to the leisure center.
- Provides a secure space that is inclusive of all play and sports. Children can play various sports in the safe, supervised area. Including, soccer, hopscotch, and even dodgeball.

## COST ESTIMATE

**\$12,750 + gst for supply & install  
for quoted dimensions**

Includes 1 year warranty and extra bolts and hardware for maintenance.

## FUNDING OPTIONS

- Combination of crowd sourced funding & corporate sponsorship then donated to the MLC
  - Municipalities do not pay GST on purchases its advantageous for the town to purchase the rink with sourced funds
- Town funded
- Combination of all of the above
