Purpose of Amendment

- To reduce the number of Direct Control Districts in the Land Use Bylaw.
- To reduce the length of the Land Use Bylaw.
- To simplify the development regulations for identified lots.
- To increase the transparency, reliability, and predictability of development.
- To reflect legislative changes for provincial election signage.
- To make minor housekeeping amendments to the Land Use Bylaw and improve clarity.

DC-2 Direct Control-Special to C-2 General Commercial
