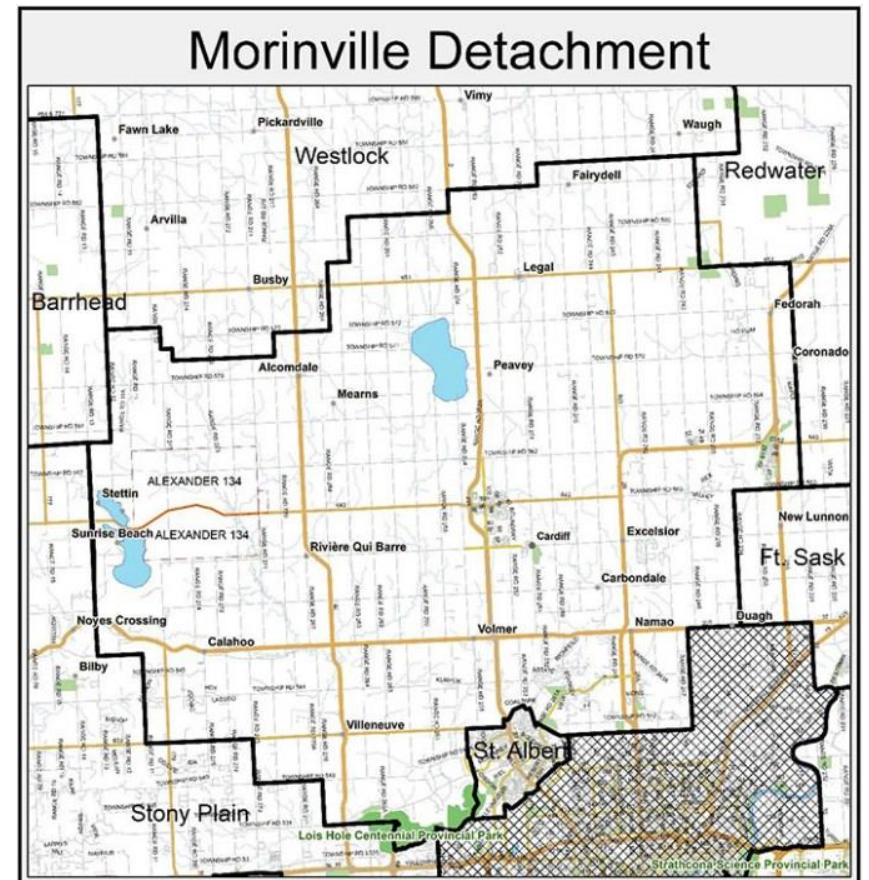

Jurisdiction and Call Volume

The Morinville R.C.M.P. Detachment provides 24-hour policing services to several municipalities and communities:

- Alexander First Nation
- Sturgeon County
- Town of Bon Accord
- Town of Gibbons
- Town of Legal
- Town of Morinville



Human Resources

The Morinville R.C.M.P. Detachment is comprised of 40 personnel:

- 1 Staff Sergeant
- 1 Sergeant
- 5 Corporals
- 18 (+1) Constables including the School Resource Officer
- 4 Public Service Employees
- 4 Town of Morinville Full Time Employees
- 5 Town of Morinville Casual Employees
- 1 Reservist Constable

Officers are supported by Sturgeon Victim Services (9 in total) and 5 guards.

Crime Statistics

The Criminal Code and Traffic Offences has seen a general reduction from the previous year.

Criminal Code:

- Person's Crime \downarrow 44 to 35 = \downarrow 20%
- Property Crime \downarrow 96 to 82 = \downarrow 15%
- Other Criminal Code \downarrow 63 to 54 = \downarrow 14%
- Total Criminal Code \downarrow 203 to 171 = \downarrow 16%

Traffic Offences:

- Criminal Code Traffic \downarrow 8 to 6 = \downarrow 25%
- Provincial Code Traffic \downarrow 131 to 119 = \downarrow 9%

Crime Reporting

Common Police Activities have seen increases in some areas and decreases in others.

Common Police Activities:

- False Alarms \downarrow 16 to 14 = \downarrow 13%
- False/Abandoned 911 Call 1 to 1 = Unchanged
- Suspicious Person/Vehicle/Property \downarrow 54 to 42 = \downarrow 22%
- Person Reported Missing \downarrow 7 to 4 = \downarrow 43%
- Spousal Abuse (Reported) \downarrow 36 to 32 = \downarrow 11%
- Mental Health Calls \uparrow 0 to 1 = \uparrow
